Bideford.

Parking:

Park in the carpark at the end of the quay, by the Kingsley statue.

Walks:

The paths around the park are flat and well surfaced, suitable for all pushchairs.

There is a café in the Burton Art Gallery, and there is also a café in the Sure Start Centre on certain days. There is often a Hockings ice cream van by the statue.

**Interests:**

For older children there is a variety of play equipment. The Burton Art Gallery is free to wander round. The park is lovely, and there are lovely views of the water from the quay as well. It is a flat and easy stroll along to the town's shops as well.
