### Location:

Down a lane off the A399 between South Molton and Ilfracombe, near Blackmoor Gate

### Entrance:

The zoo is open throughout the year from 10am. It costs £7.95 for an adult. Under 3s are free.

### Parking:

At the zoo, near the entrance.

### Walks:

Around the zoo. Most are well paved and suitable for any pushchair. There are a few that are loose gravel (as is the car park) but these can be avoided without missing anything.

### Bikes:

### Eating:

There is the Africa Café with a varied selection and quite reasonable prices and they have high chairs and even sell baby food. There is an undercover seating area outside where you can eat a picnic.

### Public Toilets:

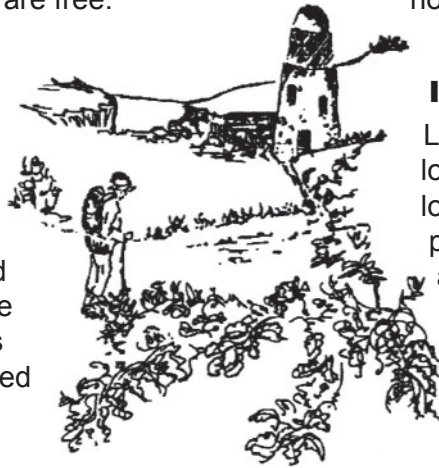
Near the cafe
